

Code of Ethics and Business Conduct

To recognize the importance to avoid fraud, waste and abuse (mismanagement) in any federally funded program, all employees must understand that Agency Code of Ethics and Business Conduct Practices, requires, but is not limited to: timely and truthful disclosure of significant accounting deficiencies and timely and truthful disclosure of non-compliance.

To ensure the prohibition of employees (as individuals or entities), from soliciting or receiving payment in kind or cash for the purchase, lease, ordering, or recommending the purchase, lease, or ordering, of any goods, facility services, or items, the AIDS Law Project's recruitment and hiring policies and procedures discourage signing bonuses and prohibit exorbitant signing bonuses.
